<b>March 4-15, 2024</b>	Parent/Guardian of students receive notification of acceptance
<b>March 4-15, 2024</b>	Students accept invitation to ECM Students apply to MCC as a new student
<b>March 11, 2024 or March 12, 2024</b>	<p><b>Mandatory ECM Student/Parent Orientation Nights:</b> Parent and student attend one session for registration / enrollment details. Registration <b>for this event</b> is not required, but attendance will be taken.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students, please complete your Macomb Community College <a href="#">Application</a>. If you need assistance, watch this <a href="#">video</a>.</li> <li>• Check your personal email for directions to the MCC's orientation process BEFORE ECM's New Student Orientation Night</li> <li>• Please bring your MCC student email with you</li> <li>• Students will have lab time to learn about the My Macomb Platform</li> </ul>
<b>Before Meeting with Seminar Instructor</b>	<p>Students have two documents to complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 year planning document</li> <li>• Junior Course packet: review and select multiple options of MCC classes to take in Fall/Winter 2024-2025. Choose classes required for high school graduation, and course that interest you.</li> <li>• <i>These selections must be done before meeting with the ECM Seminar instructor</i></li> </ul>
<b>March 14 – April 14, 2024</b>	<p>Students will receive an email from their ECM Seminar Instructor/ Counselor with directions to sign up for a 10-15 minute counseling session.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The appointment length is 10-15 minutes, and <b>a parent or guardian</b> must attend with the student</li> <li>• Appointments will be through Zoom, phone call or in-person</li> <li>• Appointments available from March 13, 2024- April 2024 after school hours, or when school is closed for spring break.</li> </ul>
<b>August 1, 2024 or August 6, 2024</b>	<p><b>Mandatory ECM Summer Camp:</b> Students only attend one. They will have an opportunity to tour campus and meet with their seminar instructor.</p> <p>August 1, 2024 – South Campus; 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. August 6, 2024 Center Campus; 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.</p> <p>Please <a href="#">Register</a> for camp.</p>
<b>Early August</b>	Students will need to pick up their college books from the campus bookstore (they can plan to do this when attending camp).
<b>August 19, 2024</b>	First day of Fall classes: All students are expected to attend MCC courses, according to MCC's academic calendar.
<b>TBD: check local district calendar</b>	First day at home high schools. Check local school district's calendar.
